COVID 19 NOTICE

You are also responsible for the compliance of anyone you bring with you to the event.

Due to Covid19;

NO pre-race dinner. We will have packet pickup at The Laurel Fairgrounds, Agricultural Building, 1457, Ellisville Blvd. Laurel, MS. on Friday night from 5-7 or may be picked up race morning. Please pickup Friday if you can.

NO Crews at aid stations

NO drop bags

NO Post Race Food

AID STATIONS: will have water, Heed and Coke. All food will be prepackaged, individual servings. Sorry but no PBJ's. There will be a variety of fuel to choose including gels. If you touch it take it or trash it. Everyone must carry a bottle or other personal hydration option.

Start in your assigned group. This is in order to reduce the number of persons at the start to the required covid numbers.

Start Times;

50 Milers 6:00 am 50K 6:10 am 20K 8:00 am

Runners must remain socially distanced until time to start their run. Face coverings will be required around the Start/Finish area, at the START and at the FINISH. You may run without face covering during the race; however, you must start with face coverings and must immediately mask up at the finish line. Runners will not be able to pick up finisher awards without face coverings. When you finish take your stuff and head away from the start/finish area.
