### Waiver/Agreement

Having read this waiver, and knowing these facts and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I, for myself and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the race organizers, its directors, officers, and staff and the city of Hattiesburg and its employees, the University of Southern Miss and its employees, and all sponsors, their representatives and successors from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons named in this waiver.

I understand that headsets of any kind, dogs on leashes, in-line skates, bicycles and vehicles to transport children are prohibited and that violation of this prohibition will result in disqualification.

## **ENTRY GUIDELINES**

- You must be a Mississippi resident to compete in the High School Championship race.
- Girls Championship Mile Athletes must have a verifiable record time of 6:00 or under in the 1600m or mile in the 2006 track season.
- Boys Championship Mile Athletes must have a verifiable record time of 4:45 or under in the 1600m or mile in the 2006 track season.
- All races are limited to 20 athletes. To guarantee your race spot, return your entry form before the deadline.
- Entry fee for Kids Mile and Open Mile races is \$15. Entry fee includes event T-shirt.
- Entry deadline is Friday, May 5, 2006.
