#### **Times**

The 5K Run/Walk race will begin at 8:00 am. The Mile Kids Run starts immediately following the 5K Run/Walk. Awards start approximately 9:30 am. The City of Morton's Day in the Park begins at 9:00 am. Stay and enjoy the day!

#### Location

Race participants will be directed to the starting line. The race start and finish is located near in front of the North Morton Baptist Church.

#### **Course Information**

Mile markers will be posted and the course has rolling hills. The course is basically an "out and back". The course will begin in front of the North Morton Baptist Church. The course will head north toward Highway 13 on Morris Tullos Drive. The course turns around before Highway 13. The course will be clearly marked with paint and traffic cones. Morris Tullos Drive will be temporarily closed for this race. Morton police and local sheriff's officers will be handling traffic control.

#### <u>Awards</u>

Specials awards will be given to recognize the overall male, female, male masters, female masters for the 5K Run/Walk and to the overall male and female for the Mile Kids Run. Age group awards will also be given to the recognize the following age groups: 15 and under, 16-20, 21-26, 27-32, 33-40, 41-50, 51-60, and over 60. Awards will be given to the respective age group finisher based on place and time finished, regardless of the event entered (run or walk). Runners and walkers are competing against each other for age group awards. *Door prizes such as free meals, food, and promotional items will also be given away*.

Water stops will be at every mile. Food and water will also be available after the race for race participants.
